

- Furnace and AC in the parsonage are working at this time.

#### Worship

- Communion Server sign-up sheet was passed around.
- Activity bags need to be checked, there are 10-12 bags. Two church members have offered to help with the bags.
- The next worship committee meeting is May 21 at 8:30 am.
- Duty sheet will be updated so greeters know what they're supposed to do regarding offering.
- Candle lighters were replaced.
- July 28<sup>th</sup> will be an ecumenical service outdoors.
- Accompanist schedule was updated for May

#### Stewardship

- Update on the cookbook. The deadline for the cookbook was May 1st to submit recipes. 45 pre-order cookbooks. Barb Murra offered to sell cookbooks at the grocery store.
- Motion was made in March to start a Kitchen savings fund. Half of the cookbook profit will go toward this fund. Fellowship offering will go toward the Kitchen fund. Is this still in the works after the grant was denied? Still discussing.
- Music and Mingle update. Waiting to hear back from music entertainers before setting a date.
- Kelsev is organizing a vertical garden through Green Stock company.

Many thanks to all the leader s for their ministry throughout the year. Pastor Eric is finalizing the plan for 2024-25. The kids will be studying the 10 Commandments for the first half of the year and then close with the Lord's Prayer during the second half. Pastor will be getting the final schedule out to the 1G leaders soon for final approval. After that, Pastor will be working on the lesson plans over the summer. Middle school 1G will take place on Mondays with the school providing transportation. Pastors Sue and Janelle will be working with superintendent Joe Erickson on the details.

Confirmation wrapped up the year on Sunday May 12 with the end of the retreat. It has been a fantastic year.
